"I don't know how your theology works, but if Jesus has a choice between stained glass

windows and feeding starving kids in Haiti, I have a feeling he'd choose the starving kids in Haiti." ~ Tony Campolo

"He saved us in order that He might begin to transform His world into the kind of world that He willed for it to be when He created it. ... When Jesus saved us, He saved us to be agents of a great revolution, the end of which will come when the kingdoms of this world will become the Kingdom of our God" ~ Tony Campolo

"In baptism, new Christians become part of a body of fellow believers who are called to spiritually encourage one another and hold one another responsible for consistent Christian living." ~ Tony Campolo *
